

#### FROM OUR TEMPLE PRESIDENT

Temple Emanuel's Trio of Ingredients (Flexibility, Spirituality & Audacious Hospitality)

Weekend with family and friends. The hot, lazy, I found the experience very exhilarating.

May 14, 2019 meeting reviewed four (4) different proposals for updated, integrated security systems. Based upon this review the Board of Trustees approved the purchase of an integrated system by ADT Security. This upgraded system will provide video surveillance and storage, burglary monitoring, access control, remote arm/disarm, and fire monitoring. The installation process will take approximately two weeks once the

equipment is ordered and plans are underway to start by the middle of June 2019. The expense associated with this upgrade was graciously underwritten by The Gale Foundation following the tragedy of the Tree of Life Synagogue.

I also want to share my experience with the congregation regarding the Social Justice Conference (SJC) sponsored by the Women of Reform Judaism which I attended following the WRJ Board meeting. The inaugural SJC was held in Washington, D.C. and was followed by the Consultation on Conscience sponsored by the Religious Action Center (RAC). These two confer-

enjoyed a rocking concert with some of the Movement's favorite female musicians. I left feeling rejuvenated and, with the support of my WRJ sisters, better prepared to address important advocacy issues locally and more broadly.

The SJC conference was followed by The Religious Action Center of Reform Judaism's (RAC) Consultation on Conscience. While I did not attend the Consultation on Conscience I heard that it provided congregations with the opportunity to learn as well as face legislative and cultural challenges that impact some of our



deepest held beliefs and values. Social justice leaders from bat Lay Leaders for the month of May. Todah Rabah Cynthia across the Reform Jewish Movement led by example and demonstrated that there has never been a better time to repair the world. It would have been a great follow-up to the spectacular Social Justice Conference.

The work of the Rabbinic Search Task Force continues into the summer months. Dr. Wayne Margolis and I had the opportunity to interview a potential student rabbinic candidate for a summer internship and we have one additional interview be-concerns. fore we make a recommendation to the Board of Trustees regarding this internship. If the Board of Trustees is in agreement to entering into a summer internship, then, Temple Emanuel could have student rabbi coverage thru the summer months for Friday night services, Torah study on Saturday morning and Havdalah Saturday evening.

I would be remiss if I did not take this time to thank our Shab-

Wolf for creating a spiritual Social Justice Shabbat as well as all congregational members who participated in the service that evening. I would also like to thank Bruce Hoffer and Marleen Swerdlow for leading services in May 2019. Our congregational family is amazing and I thank each of you for your continued love of Torah and the Jewish people.

#### SWEET NOODLE KUGEL

Spray 9x13 inch pan-Preheat Oven 325 degrees

#### You will need:

- 1 8 oz. package extra wide noodles, cooked for about 4 minutes and drained. They will continue to cook while being heated later.
- 3/4 stick melted butter
- ½ C sugar
- 3 eggs beaten well
- 1 C cream, ½ & ½ or non dairy creamer
- 1 C apricot nectar

#### Topping:

- 2 C crushed corn flakes
- ½ stick melted butter
- 2 t. cinnamon (or to taste)
- 1/4 C sugar (You can use crushed Frosted Flakes and skip the sugar)

Mix cooked noodles in pan with eggs, sugar, cream, nectar and butter. Combine topping ingredients and sprinkle on top. Bake 45 minutes.

Freeze when cooled.
