




FROM OUR TEMPLE RABBI

FROM OUR TEMPLE PRESIDENT

Temple Emanuel's Trio of Ingredients (Flexibility, Spirituality & Audacious Hospitality)

As summer slowly comes to a close and we settle back into the familiar hum of Temple life, I sit here thinking what a wonderful summer experience our congregational family has just experienced. We had the opportunity to meet two very capable fifth year rabbinic students from the HUC-JIR campus in Cincinnati, Ohio. Both of these student rabbis breathed a breath of fresh air into our Shabbat worship.

Student Rabbi Rob's love of Judaism coupled with his enthusiasm, keen wit and all round jovial personality made attending Shabbat services a pure delight. While student Rabbi Ben was more of a reserved person from the Bimah, his D'Var Torah each week kept the congregation engaged in thoughtful consideration of social justice topics impacting the Reform Jewish Movement and the greater community at large. Both of these young men entered our sanctuary



with confidence, led services, held meaningful Torah study each Saturday morning and frequently conducted Havdalah on Saturday evening. They also made "Hospitality" calls. This concept of "Hospitality" calls was new to me. Essentially, they visited and/or called members of the congregation who were not able to attend services or other activities during their visits. From my discussions with them, I learned that this is something that is now incorporated into their studies. Both of them met with members of the congregation and their families during difficult times in their life. I have heard nothing but positive comments about how they offered comfort and prayer at this most important time. While they both have returned to Cincinnati to completed their fifth year of rabbinic education, I feel privileged to have had the opportunity to meet and work with two truly amazing young Jewish adults.

I would also like to thank the Board of Trustees for stepping up and assure that services were well attended each week. I appreciate the time each of you took to contact our members to remind them about Shabbat services, Torah study and Havdalah each week. The fact that on average, over the 8 week period, we had 35 members present each Friday night for Shabbat Services is to be applauded. I hope that this type of participation continues as we move forward this fall and into the High Holiday season. Lastly, our Office Manager, Jane Kaulfus needs to be thanked for her wonderful coordination of hotel visits and for maintaining a master itinerary for each visit. It certainly made things easy for all involved. Because we had students for

most of the summer we only had two weekends that required Lay Members to conduct Shabbat services. I would be remiss if I did not take this time to thank our Shabbat Lay Leaders for June 14, 2019 and August 30, 2019. *Todah Rabah* Sherry & Paul Horwitz and Marleen Swerdlow. Your continued support of Temple Emanuel is amazing and I thank you each for your continued love of Torah and the Jewish people.

The Rabbinic Search Task Force met several times over the summer. Our focus was on revising the application to be uploaded to the CCAR website in September 2019. We also had a joint Task Force Meeting and Board of Trustees meeting in July 2019 to review strategies of the Rabbinic Search moving forward. The Board reviewed these strategies in detail at its August 2019 Board meeting and will keep the congregation aware of the outcome.

I would also like the congregation to be aware of a bequest from The Gale Foundation. Temple Emanuel will be one of several benefactors to receive a sizeable contribution from The Gale Foundation; Rebecca Gale, and Edwin Gale (z"l). As a result of this bequest, the Sanctuary will be rededicated on October 25, 2019 as "The Gale Foundation Sanctuary" as part of Shabbat Services. Members of The Gale Foundation as well as family members will be present for this rededication. I hope everyone will make plans to attend Shabbat services that Friday evening.

Lastly, as we prepare for the High Holidays, I would like to ask for forgiveness for any sins I may have made against any member of this congregation. I also want to wish you a *L'shanah tovah tikateivu v'teichateimu*, A good year. May you be inscribed and sealed (for blessing in the Book of Life).
